To test this:			
1. Load the Order Entry WS			
2. Load Order.vw			
3. Scroll down to say line 43			
4. The code collapse [-] should be on line 43			
5. Now click the space between the [-] symbol on line 43 and the next [-] on line 52 – not the actual [-] symbol			
6. Notice the code collapses ? This can have a weird effect if you just start clicking
